Targets suggested by the law

- **restore** habitats and species
- **reverse the decline** of pollinators by 2030
- **no net loss** of green urban spaces by 2030
- **a minimum of 10% tree canopy** cover in European cities
- **healthier forests** with improved biodiversity
- at least 25.000 km **free-flowing rivers** by 2030

By restoring nature, we invest in a sustainable, resilient and more productive future



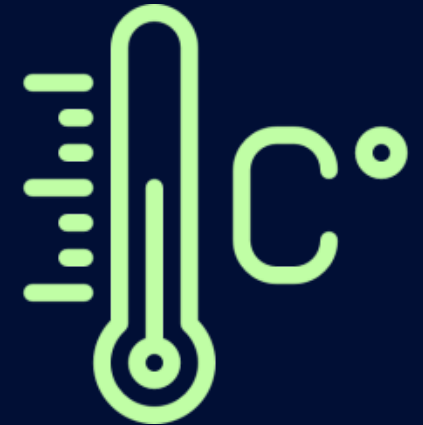
Every EUR spent in land restoration brings an economic return of EUR 8 to EUR 38



Restoring drained peatlands could save up to 25% of Europe's land-based greenhouse gas emissions



Water areas absorb floodwaters more effectively and at lower cost than any human-made structure
